• As <u>witnesses</u> we <u>cooperate</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>.

Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. 31 But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his John 20:30-31 name.

- As <u>witnesses</u> we <u>cooperate</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>.
- As a witness, <u>share</u> what you <u>know</u>.
- As witnesses we <u>point</u> at <u>Jesus</u>.

"See, I will send you the prophet Elijah before that great and dreadful day of the LORD comes. 6 He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers; or else I will come and strike the land with a curse." Malachi 4:5-6

And if you are willing to accept it, he is the Elijah who was to come.

- As <u>witnesses</u> we <u>cooperate</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>.
- As a witness, <u>share</u> what you <u>know</u>.
- As witnesses we point at <u>Jesus</u>.
- We may be <u>surprised</u> how <u>close</u> Jesus is to people.

- A witness needs two qualities:
 - A personal experience.
 - The commitment to talk about it.
