Exodus 29:42–43



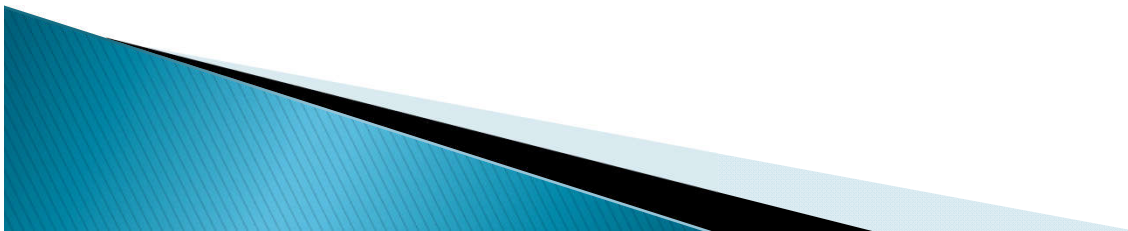
